




Climate Change is increasingly affecting cities in a variety of ways


Being often located in exposed areas near coasts, rivers, deltas or mountain slopes, informal settlements are the most prone to these shocks.

More resilient and inclusive cities based on climate adaptive solutions and global and local partnerships will enable cities to become more resilient and improving the lives of their citizens.
















