
Role of MTSU

Current Activities of MTSU

- ➤ Preparation of Concept Plan for MMR
- ➤ Study on Environmental Impact in Mumbai
- ➤ Study on suitable financial model for <u>MTHL</u>
- ➤ Study on performance of various <u>PPP models</u> in MCGM schools
- ➤ Assisting State Govt. in setting up <u>Regulatory</u> <u>Authority</u> for housing sector
- ➤ Assisting State Govt. in implementing <u>vocational</u> <u>courses</u> through Skill Development Scheme

Achievements in Mumbai Transformation

1. Transport Infrastructure Sector

- Bandra Worli Sea Link operational
- All arterial roads in Mumbai strengthened and a number of fly-overs completed under **MUIP**
- MUTP 1 nearing completion, MUTP 2 to start soon
- Work of Metro Corridor 1 started
- Work of **Metro** Corridor 2 to start soon
- Work of Monorail corridor 1 started
- Eastern Freeway work in progress
- Airport modernization work in full swing

Achievements in Mumbai Transformation

2. Water and Sanitation Infrastructure

- **Storm water** drainage project (BRIMSTOWAD) under implementation
- Sewage disposal project (MSDP) under implementation
- Middle Vaitarna Dam water supply project under implementation
- Mithi river development Phase 1 completed, Phase 2 in progress

Achievements in Mumbai Transformation

3. Housing Sector

- Housing Policy declared by GoM adopting cluster redevelopment approach and rental housing
- Work of a large number of rental houses started
- Urban Land Ceiling Act repealed

4. Governance Issues

- Metropolitan Planning Council formed
- Unified Metropolitan Transport Authority (UMTA) set up
